



The Center for Early Education Alumni Council By-laws

Mission

The purpose of the Alumni Council of The Center for Early Education is to uphold the mission of The Center by creating and sustaining the bonds amongst alumni and between The Center and its alumni. The Committee will support and create engaging programming for all alumni that are mutually beneficial to the alumni and The Center.

Eligibility

Any student who attended The Center for Early Education for at least one year and left or graduated from the school in good standing is considered a member of the alumni community and is therefore eligible for Alumni Council membership.

Membership

The Alumni Council of The Center for Early Education shall consist of any alumni, 21 years of age or older, who is interested and willing to provide Alumni leadership. At the end of each school year, membership will be evaluated; should a member be unable to fulfill the duties listed below, their membership will be revoked for the next year.

Duties

1. Attend at least three (3) Alumni Council meetings and alumni events per school year
2. Serve as a Class Agent; contact classmates and promote involvement in alumni programming throughout the course of the year, and assist in gathering information (i.e. births, marriages, promotions, honors etc.) for publications such as the Alumni Newsletter and The Center Newsletter
3. Support the school by contributing to the Annual Fund Drive and other fundraising efforts and inspiring other alumni to give to The Center. Actively solicit AFD contributions from classmates annually
4. Serve on one (1) committee per year (appointment by Alumni Office):
 - a. Annual Fund
 - b. Community Service
 - c. Events
 - d. Media
 - e. Networking
5. Organize, promote, and participate in reunions and other Alumni/all school events

Amendments

Any Council member may propose to amend any by-law. The member must submit the proposed amendment to the Alumni Council in writing which will be discussed and voted on at the next Council meeting, following the written notice. The amendment shall be enacted by a vote of approval by two-thirds of the current Council.
